- This program offers one time college scholarships to eligible graduating high school seniors in participating states.
- Applicants must be in good academic standing with no less than a 3.0 GPA supported by an official transcript.
- Students interested in applying should have a strong interest in the shooting sports and the Second Amendment that will be pursued in College as well.
- A short essay (500 words or less) must be submitted along with the application. You may write on the importance of the Second Amendment, or, how the shooting sports have contributed to your personal development.
- Applicants must include a copy of their letter of acceptance to their chosen college or university.
- Applicants must include a letter of reference from a school administrator, advisor, teacher, or coach.
- Applications for submission must be postmarked no later than June 1, 2020.

The scholarship winners will be selected in June. Winners will be notified immediately following the decisions. Please complete the application form, sign and date it, and submit the form along with your essay, your official high school transcript, your letter of reference, and your letter of acceptance on or before June 1, 2020.
